Rules and Regulations

- Team of 2 participants (public officers) plus one as alternate.
- Questions will be either in English or French and answers to be given accordingly.
- All teams to play at the same time.
- Answers to be written on a mini whiteboard.
- A mini whiteboard, marker and duster will be provided.
- Allocated time - 20 seconds to answer each question.
- Mark allocated - 1 point for each good answer.
- A series of 15 questions will be set for preliminaries and 20 questions for the final.
- Questions will be based on general knowledge (sports, history, geography, literature, local and international events, music, people, etc.)
- Only one answer will be accepted each time.
- Answers should be legible.
- Grammatical errors will not be taken into account but rather on the phonetical aspect of answers.
- The two best teams of each preliminary will be qualified for the final.
